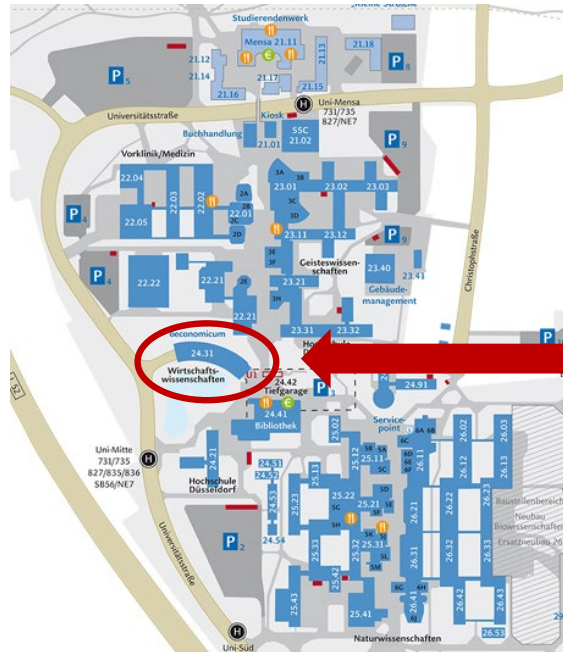
General Information



- Registration for exams (if online not possible),
- Processing of withdrawals, notifications of sickness,
- Issuing of overviews of grades and certificates.

- Does not provide information on exam results!

- Please be aware of deadlines for exam registration (are posted [online](#))
 - Registration via student portal (Studierendenportal)
 - Registration period in this year:
 - Winter: 28th of November 2022 – 16th of December 2022
 - Summer: 15th of May 2023 – 2nd of June 2023
 - Afterwards, no registration possible
- Withdrawal of registration up until 7 days previous to exam without giving explanations (online)
 - Afterwards only in urgent cases, such as illness (certificate needed, must be issued on the day of the exam; [check online](#) for the documents necessary)

If there are problems or discrepancies, immediately contact the Student and Examination Administration!

- Exams in compulsory elective modules
 - Offered at the end of the course (typically once a year in winter or summer)
 - You can register for the first or second examination date
 - If you fail the first attempt, you are automatically registered for the second
 - Registrations for further attempts need to be done by the student
 - If you fail for the second time, the third try must be within 15 months after second try
 - Please be aware, that once you participated in an exam, you have to finish the module!
- Exams in compulsory courses
 - Offered once each semester after the lecture period

- Other forms of examinations called “sonstige Prüfungsleistung” can only be retried if the module is offered again.
- Students need to register online in the given time period again.

- Exams offered by other faculties follow the rules of the respective faculty

Please check the list of allowed calculators [online!](#)

- You finish your studies with a master thesis.
- The working time is typically 6 months (Economics) or 4 months (VWL).
- The deadline can be extended for 2 weeks on a duly substantiated request.
- The topic can be withdrawn (once) within two weeks after registration.

- You apply for the thesis in the „Studierendenportal“, where you choose a supervisor and propose a topic.
- Your application is processed and you will be informed via e-mail if it was successful.

- **The thesis is usually handed in electronically and needs to be within the deadline!** If you are sick and need an extension, immediately contact the Board of Examination (Prüfungsausschuss). Also make sure to document the reason for your request, e.g. doctor's certificate.
